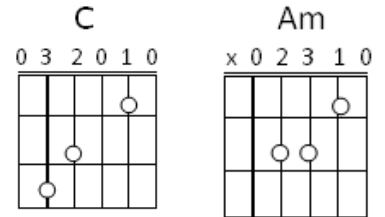


Intro: C, Am, Dm, F, Dm, G7, C,

(One 2.3.4: etc)

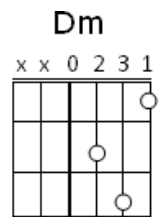
V1. If you miss the train I'm on, you will know that I am gone,

A hundred miles, a hundred miles,

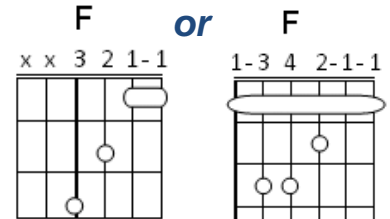
Dm G7 C

Lord I'm five- hundred miles from my home.

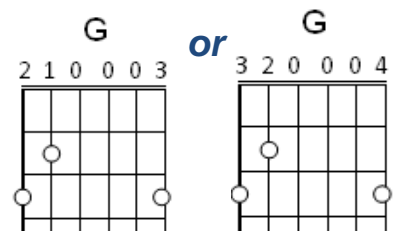
C Am Dm F

V.3. Not a shirt on my back, not a penny to my name,

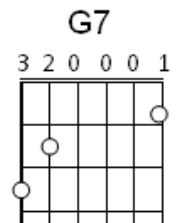
C Am Dm F
