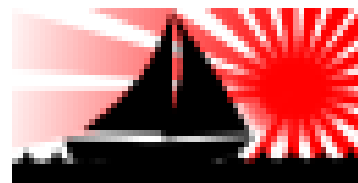


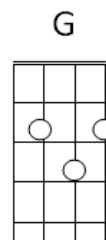

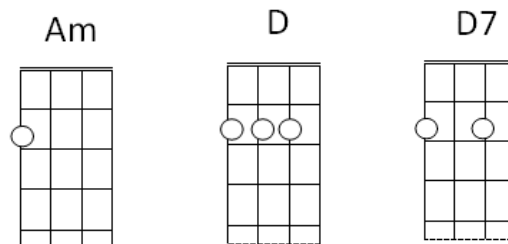
V.1. Leaving on a boat for be-yond the other side of the o- cean,

 Might as well be living on the other side of the sun.



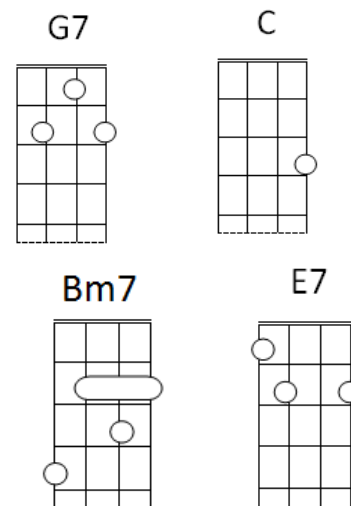

 From be-yond the other side of the sun.



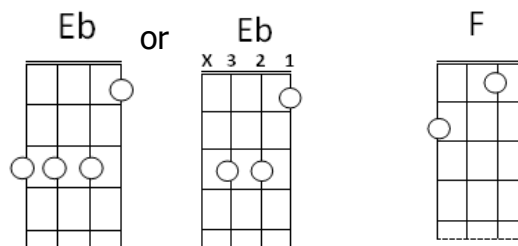
V.3. Rollin' down the river I hope I can deliver the morning,
